Monday – Travel day, leave CSIA approx. 12am, arrive in Paris early evening, pancake making at the centre.




Isles of Scilly

PGL—Barton Hall, Devon



A week of adventure, team work, new experiences and challenges. We will spend the week at PGL Barton Hall in Torquay. Each day involves 4 different activities, each lasting 90 minutes. Activities will include abseiling, archery, buggy building, canoeing, climbing and many more; students will experience 14 activities in total. There will also be lots of team games and an activity each evening such as capture the flag and a campfire. Accommodation will be in dormitories. Food is provided for the week including cereals and cooked breakfast, hot and cold options for both lunch and dinner with a salad bar and fruit available.

Football and Netball Sports Tour

Get ready for added excitement with a tack and turnout (grooming) competition, a gymkhana (an assault course on a horse), and other fun competitions.


History Tour

Cornwall Inter-Railing

We'll visit Newquay, Truro, St Ives, Penzance and Falmouth, enjoying the activities on offer in each town before travelling back to Camborne each day. Look forward to a week of Amusement Arcades, BBQs, Boat trips, Swimming, Cinema, Museums and Escape Rooms.

Fishing



Back by popular demand, this student favourite returns for another week of lake and sea fishing. Get ready to tie on those rigs, cast into the water and get ready to reel in those catches.

The week will have a mix of different locations including sea fishing from a boat. All equipment provided if necessary.

Surfing



Intended activities throughout the visit will include the following:

- Surfing (2 sessions a day, conditions permitting)**
- An opportunity to learn about the Cornish coastline.
- A certificate of completion.
- Certified Instructors coaching the sessions.
- Possibly beach activities and swimming which is weather and conditions (tide, currents) dependent.

- Increased self-confidence, motivation and direction to achieve success.
- Renewed appreciation for the environment.
- Develop teamwork skills, perseverance and resilience.

Master Chef





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How to apply for your child's Activities Week 2024

Please read through the brochure with your child carefully to find three suitable activities you would like to apply for. Once your child has made their three choices, you will need to complete the Activities Week preferences form (tear out the last page) and return to your form tutor by Friday 3rd November 2023. Applications received after this date will only be considered after the first round of allocations. It is essential that the application form is completed by the parent/carer. Following the closing date above, we will begin the allocation process. As long as your application form has been submitted by the deadline, we will try our best to ensure your child is allocated a place on the activity with their highest preference. Please be aware that, due to there being a limited number of spaces, it may not always be possible to allocate your child a place in their first or second choice activities.

This year, students in Year 9 will be given priority for all international and residential trips, as this may be their last opportunity to take part in this type of activity

Once allocations have been completed, you will receive a communication confirming your child's place along with payment information. Shortly after you receive your confirmation letter, an activity week 2024 item will be set up on your ParentPay account so you can begin making payments. If your child does not wish to take up their place on their allocated activity, please inform your form tutor immediately so your place can be offered to another student. Your child can then be offered a place on a different activity with space.

Payments can be made over a period of time as per the payment schedule contained in your confirmation letter, but the initial non-refundable deposit 25% will be due by 4th Dec, followed by 3 further deadline points. Smaller payments can be made at any time via parent pay and the dates shared in your confirmation letter will be deadlines for payment amounts. Failure to keep up with he payments could result in your child's place being removed from the activity as we need these payments to secure places with external bookings agents.
