- Y13s average GCSE score on entry was 6.10 (6.10, 6.15, 5.85) and therefore on average similar to previous years although the student profile is more in the middle ability range with less spread at top and bottom.
- Number of Year 13 Students taking 1 or more exam lower than last year 51 (93, 63)
- Number of Students who gained AAB or higher in 2+ facilitating subjects is much lower at 6.9% (14.30%, 8%, 0%) vs. National Average for State schools of 11.8% however percentage of places to Russell Group universities is higher than national average. This is also a reflection of number of students with A/B targets compared to 2016
- Students achieved particularly well in Maths and Sciences with A\*-B of 93% (83%) and 65% (62%) respectively vs 2015 Nat Av of 63.8% (Maths) and approximately 50% (Science)
