Progress 8 and Attainment 8

Progress 8 is based on students' progress measured across eight subjects:

- English;
- Mathematics;
- Three other English Baccalaureate (EBacc) subjects (sciences, computer science, geography, history and languages).
- Three further subjects, which can be from the range of EBacc subjects, or can be any other GCSE or approved, high-value arts, academic, or vocational qualification.

Attainment 8 is the students' average achievement across these eight subjects.

The Attainment 8 data indicates that all students at CSIA achieve higher grades in their subjects than students do nationally. There is a gap between PP and non-PP students at CSIA; however, it is clear that PP students at CSIA are attaining higher grades than PP students nationally.

The Progress 8 data shows that all students at CSIA make good progress against national figures; Pupil Premium (PP) students at CSIA make better progress than similar students nationally however there is a gap between our PP students and non PP students. This is particularly the case for our low prior attainment students. Therefore, we will continue to focus our efforts on closing the gap for our PP students against our non-PP students at CSIA.
