Dear Parent/Carer,

All students in Years 7 – 9 will be attending the annual Camborne Science and International Academy Sports Day at Carn Brea Leisure Centre on Wednesday 11th July 2018. It is hoped that your son/daughter will represent their tutor group. If your son/daughter is not participating in the day, they will be required to still attend this event and support their tutor group. If your son/daughter is not taking part then they will be required to wear their full school uniform.

Please ensure your son/daughter is prepared for the day. They must bring:

- Correct school PE kit
- Suitable clothing for any eventuality (sun hat, warm clothes and waterproofs)
- Sun cream
- Drinks (water or juice. NO cans or energy drinks please)
- Packed lunch and healthy snacks (if your son/daughter are in receipt of free school meals a packed lunch will be provided)
- Any medication (including inhalers)

Students participating must attend school in their PE kit and register in their tutor rooms as normal. Their tutor will then inform them of further instructions. After the event, your child will return to school and leave at 2.45pm as usual. **If you are attending the event and would like to take your child home with you immediately afterwards, please inform their form tutor by letter by Monday 9th July 2018.**

Unfortunately, without written consent, in advance, students will not be permitted to leave Carn Brea Leisure Centre. Please do not inform us on the day that you would like to take your child home with you. Both our safeguarding and transport requirements mean that may not be possible. We appreciate your support in this matter.

The PE faculty would also like to invite parents to support their children at this event. There will be a spectators' area provided for parents who wish to encourage their children. Unfortunately, due to safeguarding consideration, parents will not be allowed on any areas of the track, field or student grandstand.

In the event of an emergency we will be referring to the Parental Consent Form that you completed for use during this academic year, commencing September 2017. If there have been changes to any of the information you have submitted about your contact details or your child's medical needs, then please request a replacement form from your child's Pastoral Support Worker. This must be submitted prior to the visit. It is vital that all students who suffer from asthma have their inhaler at all times. **They will not be allowed to compete if they do not bring this**, even if it is mild or irregular.
