Dear Parent/Carer

Following the advice given by Public Health England to instruct students in Year 8 to self-isolate, I am writing to provide information about how your child can access their curriculum from home.

Whilst students are self-isolating, there is an expectation that they continue to follow their timetable and take part in their learning from home. Students must log into their Google Classroom at the same time as their lesson so that they can receive support and feedback from their teacher. Teachers will only be online to support your child during the allocated teaching slot because they will have other lessons to deliver. Please note that we do not set work for Physical Education lessons but we do encourage students to take part in physical activity during this time.

How do I access the work?

1. Log into Google Classroom
2. Enter the code for your child's tutor group (students only need to enter one tutor group to access their learning)
3. Click the 'Classwork' tab
4. Look for the subject
5. Look for the work allocated for the appropriate date and time
6. Complete work
7. Use the private comments to talk to teachers and receive feedback
