End of Term Arrangements & Student Return in January 2022

Friday 17 December 2021

On Friday 17 December students will depart school at 12.35pm for the start of their Christmas holiday. As in previous years, students can attend on this day in non-school uniform; we ask that students pay 50p to wear non-uniform, which will be donated to Camborne Foodbank. Please make all payments via Parent Pay. Students have been provided with guidance by their form tutor on appropriate clothing to wear for this occasion.

We are unable to change the bus timetable to facilitate our early finish on the last day of term, therefore please note the following arrangements for students who would usually catch a school bus home. Buses will all leave from the usual location on CSIA campus:

- Bus number 38: Praze, Trevoole – a Williams bus will replace the usual school service.
- Bus number 45: Troon, Beacon, Four Lanes, Black Rock – a Williams bus will replace the usual school service.
- Bus number 39: Reawla, Carnhell Green, Leedstown, Baripper – school minibuses will be available to take students to these locations.
- Students catching the T1/T2 home: There are 4 buses each hour, please refer to the timetable for the most appropriate bus to catch

Covid – 19 Update & Return to School in January 2022

We ask that during the Christmas holiday your son/daughter continues to test twice weekly using the LFD tests. If you need to order a LFD testing kit then please use the following link <https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests>. The Government has announced that secondary schools are to test all students for Covid on-site when we return after the Christmas holiday in January. Students where consent has already been provided will take a test on-site, followed by another at home three days later. Any student who has tested positive for Covid within the last 90 days will not be expected to test, as it may result in a false positive.

The Government have shared with schools that a staggered start can be implemented to enable the testing to happen. Please see below a table which indicates when each Year Group is being tested and when the students will return to school for lessons. When students arrive for their testing they are to go to the Sports Hall via the outside doors by the MUGA, complete the testing and then leave the school site immediately. Students will return the day after their test providing their result is negative. We will only make contact with you if the test is positive. Year 12 and 13 students will return to school on Tuesday 4th January and complete a test during tutorial and period 1 in the Sports Hall. When Year 12 and 13 arrive onsite they will go directly to their tutor room on main site, where they will be met by their form tutor. Year 12 & 13 will be in normal lessons for the remainder of the day.
