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Dear Parent/Carer

At Camborne Science and International Academy, we have taken on an exciting opportunity to support your child further in maths during this time of remote learning. All KS3 students now have full access to Maths Whizz: an online programme designed to build confidence and accelerate progress in Maths. We are making it available now to support your child's learning at home. The school are able to monitor the progress remotely to ensure that your child is engaging with the programme (recommended usage of 45-60 minutes per week) and making good progress. Your child can do this in small chunks over the week or in a single session.

As part of their normal maths lessons, each student should now have completed the initial assessment. However, there are some who are yet to attempt this. Please encourage your child to complete this assessment as soon as possible, if they have not already done so. All login details are on your child's maths Google Classroom. The assessment will take up to an hour. The Maths Whizz Tutor will assign them a maths Age at the end and will learn about their strengths and weaknesses during the assessment. Their maths teacher will also have access to this to help with lesson planning when they return to school. To complete the initial assessment, they should work alone and try their best so that the correct maths age is assigned to them, otherwise they will find the lessons too hard or too easy. Don't worry - a maths age of less than their actual age is perfectly normal and is not a cause for concern. We are interested in increasing your child's learning in maths over the weeks and months. Once this assessment has taken place, students can complete different tasks and activities at their own free will. The Maths Whizz Tutor will support your child's learning with engaging, interactive maths lessons that will encourage your child and support any weakness they have in a holistic and supportive way.

The Maths Whizz Tutor will offer rewards to students for their progress. They are assessed at the end of each topic. Even though your child is at home, their teacher will be able to monitor their work and reach out to them with a message via Maths Whizz, as needed, which they will see when they log in.

There is also the opportunity for you, the parent/carer, to engage with Maths Whizz where you can send your child a message to offer further support and motivation. Instructions on the following page explain how you can activate your own account. This will also allow you, as a parent/carer, to monitor your child's engagement with Maths Whizz, encouraging them to use the programme for between 45-60 minutes per week.
