

Disorder St Ives /Hayle

It has come to the attention of Devon & Cornwall Police that children have recently been arranging parties at Hayle Towans and Porthminster Beach, St Ives. These are predominantly happening on a Friday or Saturday night and have involved youths from all over West Cornwall.

We have had multiple reports of disorder, allegations of assault, alcohol abuse, drug use and youths carrying weapons, which has resulted in many Police resources being required to diffuse the situation and arrests being made.

We would like to ask all parents to work with us to ensure that children remain safe. We have been informed that some parents are giving their children alcohol and we strongly advise against this. Another recent trend is the use of vapes both legal and illegal by youths, this is a dangerous practice as the use of these has had a detrimental effect on the health of youths and has resulted in hospitalisation in some cases.

Please note that alcohol, drug and vape, legal and illegal misuse is resulting in teenagers being placed at risk, subsequently ending up in vulnerable situations and they could be liable to arrest.

We would greatly appreciate your support with this matter to keep your children safe.
